

# Masks One by One

## Instructions

- Using the pattern and materials included sew 10 masks. For alternate instructions and FAQ go to <https://seattlenorthrs.home.blog/masks/>
- You are welcome to distribute the masks to your family, ministering sisters/brothers, neighbors or other causes but please let us know where you donate them so we can keep track of how masks are distributed. To do this go to <https://tinyurl.com/masks-given>
- Return finished masks in the bag that you received them to the person/hot spot where you picked up the kit. Please put your name on the bag. They will be donated to an organization in need. The website <https://seattlenorthrs.home.blog/masks/> will keep up to date on who we are donating to at the time. **\*\*PLEASE READ PACKING INSTRUCTIONS BELOW\*\***

- Consider donating: We could always use more fabric and materials. Go to <https://tinyurl.com/masks-donate> to donate.

## Safety notes:

- DO NOT make masks if you or anyone in your household is sick.
- Make sure your work environment is clean, free from pets, food, smoke, anyone with colds/flu/etc, and anyone not helping to assemble.
- Sanitize your work surfaces and all tools before use.
- Wash your hands and be aware of touching any unclean surfaces (or your face!). If you do, please wash your hands again before continuing.

## General notes:

- These are not N95 or PPE and are not intended for clinical use
- These are homemade—please tell family/friends/neighbors to wash before using.
- Make sure your material is pre-shrunk, 100% cotton, tightly knit/woven fabric (if you are using material from us, it will be)
- When you are picking up or delivering masks/kits, please avoid in-person contact, instead transferring via porch drop-offs, etc.

## Packing Instructions:

If you are returning masks to us to give to our community partners:

- Label a clean ziplock bag with the number of masks you have made and write “Homemade cloth masks--Please Wash Before Use!” (you can use the ziplock bag from the kit—please make sure it has been kept clean)
- Wash your hands and make sure you have a clean iron handle/surface to work on
- Steam iron both sides of each mask (to sanitize) and place it immediately in the ziplock bag. Once it has the number of masks specified, seal it. (Also include one of the “Mask Care Instructions” printouts)
- The bag is now ready for delivery!
